
tension the Lamborghini brand is extreme, uncompromising, and Italian." (Lamborghini Magazine, #001)


Midwest Demographics - Michigan






Technical Talk - Crankshaft Thrust Bearings

Most people, including myself, have never heard or thought of this, but on the Countach and Diablo it is better on the engine to start the car with the clutch pedal not pressed in. Although you have to be safe—and certain that the vehicle is NOT in gear, this practice significantly reduces wear on the thrust bearings in the engine. The thrust bearings are the two bearings located on each side of the center crankshaft bearing (they keep the crankshaft in position from front to back). When the clutch is pressed in, the crank is either pushed or pulled depending on your clutch setup, causing the crank to be pressed against the thrust bearing. The thrust bearing was designed for this load, but on startup the bearing is dry. Now, although much of the engine's moving parts are dry on start-up, this bearing wears substantially when dry because of the force exerted on it by the crankshaft. Once the thrust bearings are worn, the side-load moves to other parts connected to the crank, which were not designed for side-load. If the crankshaft travel is bad enough, parts of the engine can be damaged. This is not an issue on most other cars because they have larger/tougher thrust bearings, but the Countach/Diablo thrust bearings are not as robust, causing this problem.

Some argue it is bad practice to start the car with the clutch petal not pressed in because it places more wear on the starter. Although this is true (because the starter then has to spin the clutch and transmission shaft in addition to the engine drive train), starter wear is far less expensive compared to the cost of replacing thrust bearings.

If your engine is out of your car for maintenance, checking these bearings is a good idea. All that is required is a dial indicator and some force on the other end of the shaft to check for play. A good Lamborghini mechanic, however, will already have this on his list of things to check for while the engine is out for service.
