Italian Cars at Pocono

Working together with the representative manufacturers, dealers, and clubs, the Italian Cars Group has established Le Belle Macchine d'Italia as the premier Italian automotive event in the Northeast. Accordingly, Le Belle Macchine d'Italia is the largest 3 day Italian automotive event in North America. The 2006 edition marked the 20th annual gathering of owners of Italian cars taking place in the beautiful Pocono Mountains of Eastern Pennsylvania.

Since 1987, owners of Ferraris, Maseratis and Lamborghinis have been gathering in the beautiful mountains of Eastern Pennsylvania for a Concorso and two days

of high-speed driving at Pocono International Raceway. The following year, De-Tomaso owners were invited to attend. The event continued unchanged until 1996, when Alfa Romeo, Fiat, Iso/Bizzarrini, and Lancia owners were invited. The

expansion continued in 1997 with the addition of Italian motorcycles such as Bimota, Ducati, & Moto Guzzi.

Over the history of this premier event, several distinguished guests have visited this now-famous event. Some of past years' guests include: His Excellency Ferdinando Salleo, the Ambassador of Italy, former Pininfarina & Ghia designer Tom Tjaarda, then-



president of Lamborghini SpA, Dott. G. Grecco, Valentino Balboni, original Lamborghini factory test driver, among several other notables. Over the years, several key events have also taken place at Le Belle Macchine d'Italia. Some of the most noteworthy include: the very first public demonstration of the Lamborghini Diablo Roadster R, television show "Extreme Machines" filmed their segment on Lamborghini live from the event, and factory technicians inspect all Lamborghinis prior to track sessions.

Le Belle Macchine d'Italia, held the weekend of June 23-26 this year, was jam-packed with a wide selection of

events for owners, as well as, enthusiasts of many types of Italian exotics, including Lamborghini. The Skytop Lodge in Skytop, Pennsylvania served as the host hotel and Concorso site for this year's event. The driving event, as in years past, took place at Pocono International Raceway. Included in the driving event was professional instruction provided from the Stockcar Racing Experience.

This year at the Concorso, more than fifty Lamborghinis were in attendance, surpassing the numbers present from any other marque. This was the first year that Lamborghini presence beat that of Ferrari – making it quite a success! Many notable members of the Lamborghini staff, from both the factory and Lamborghini Technical services, were also present. Among those present were Valentino Balboni, Barbara Adamoli, Rene Suelzter, James DelConte, and Jonathan Kirshtein. In addition, several Midwest Lamborghini owners and one Midwest dealership, Lamborghini Ohio, also made the trip, making a strong showing for the Lamborghini marque.

The weather remained beautiful for the duration of the Concorso, giving all spectators an excellent opportunity to meet and greet with other owners and enthusiasts, along with hands-on viewing of several models of many Italian exotics. One of the best cars, easily the highlight of the show, was a perfectly-restored green Miura SV, which also took top honors in the Mid-Engine Lamborghini class. The driving event at Le Belle Macchine d'Italia, which was unfortunately rained out this year, is a private event for owners, club members & invited guests only. The track at Pocono International Raceway features a 2.5 mile road course with 8 turns: two "S" style turns, a 170 degree hairpin, and two 3,000 + ft. straights joined by a 16-degree banked turn providing the opportunity to drive one of the foremost super speedways in the country. All track eligible cars must pass an extensive tech inspection performed by technical experts from each marque.

Needless to say, the 20th anniversary of Le Belle Macchine d'Italia lived up to everyone's expectations.



Midwest Demographics - Illinois

Updated numbers!! There are now over 528 Lamborghinis in the Midwest region; Lamborghinis are definitely gaining more and more popularity!

Lamborghini Chicago Driving Day at the Autobahn CC

Despite the near triple digit temperatures and glaring sun shine, spirits were high as a sizeable group of Italian super cars and distinguished guests descended into Joliet, Illinois' very own backyard; the Autobahn Country Club.

The Autobahn Country Club is located on 320 acres in Joliet Illinois, just 45 minutes from Chicago, traffic permitting, of course. The 3.56 mile combined north and south circuit is one of the three largest tracks in the Midwest. Investors enlisted the help of road course designer Alan Wilson, who has designed tracks such as: Barber Motorsports Park, Arizona Motorsports Park, Gingerman Raceway, and South Carolina Motorsports Park to design the ABCC. His designs prove to be challenging and fun, yet remain focused on safety.

After a short classroom session provided by the instructors at the ABCC on basic vehicle dynamics, track etiquette, and explanation of flags, the group was divided up according to experience. Morning "workshops" allowed drivers to feel these dynamics first hand on track. An emergency stopping, obstacle avoidance, and slalom course were placed throughout the 2.1 mile south circuit.

After lunch and a group picture, everyone was invited to tour the south circuit as famed Lamborghini test driver Valentino Balboni led the laps in a blu caelum 2006 Gallardo coupe. For those on a track for the first time, even the slower pace provided a rush.



Rolling out onto the track, I felt the immediate response of the V10 behind us as we rocketed towards turn one. The song "Flight of the Valkyries" by Richard Wagner plays in my head. The smooth up shifts of the e-gear kept pulling us forward, only immediately to be met by the equally smooth down shifts, accompanied by the most violent sound of a ten-cylinder symphony screaming from the Gallardo's engine bay. As Valentino starts conducting this performance, I knew I would be in for quite a show. The strings sound of four squealing Pirelli tires in an almost gravity-defying power slide through all of the turns was joined by the brass section of hard shifts from the e-gear. In comes the percussion rumble of 520 brake horse power in forte only to have the entire ensemble combine for a most beautiful sound and feel.

Thanking Valentino, I shook his hand and exited from the car with a new found appreciation and experience. It was the perfect way to end a wonderful day in the presence of the most incredible automobiles in the world.

Grattan, much like all other raceways, is booked for closed events during the entire driving season. Thankfully, though, Lamborghini Troy planned the event well enough in time! The weather held up, too, providing a nice and sunny day in western Michigan – perfect driving conditions!

All of those who attended had a wonderful time getting to know other Lamborghini owners, as well as, more about their car. Several owners drove at their own pace and took time talking with the instructors to learn more about driving their cars on and off the track. The track, though, provided an opportunity to not worry about outside factors when driving on everyday roads, i.e. potholes, police, etc. So, if you wanted to drive your car fast (although still being safe and responsible), you were more than welcome to do so!

Around the midway point of the event, lunch was provided, offering a nice opportunity to once again meet up with everyone and spend some time getting to know one another. After lunch, Valentino was available and offering track rides with those who were interested in

the once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. As you may already know, Valentino has logged more driving time in a Lamborghini than anyone else – and has mastered the car beyond most people's belief, even world class engineers at Lamborghini.

The event could not have been more of a success. Thanks for all the owners who attended – pass on your thoughts of the experience to other fellow owners, and next year's event can be as much, if not more, of a success! 
