Eyes on Design, Honoring Marcello Gandini

Held this year at the Edsel and Eleanor Ford Estate in Grosse Pointe Shores, Michigan, the 20th International Celebration of Automotive Design (Eyes on Design) is a unique celebration of design in all forms, but not strictly because of attributes like vehicle rarity, restoration or celebrity ownership. It is the importance of automotive design that drives this celebration, for, without great design, a thriving automotive industry would be nearly impossible!

This year, the Lifetime Design Achievement award went to famous designer, Marcello Gandini. Gandini has added his touch to many well-known auto designs, including the Lamborghini Miura, Espada, Jarama, Urraco Countach, and Diablo (with the exception of the Diablo, all were done while working for Bertone). Gandini also designed the Lamborghini Marzal. Unfortunately, the vehicle never made it further than the concept stage. Born on August 26, 1938, Gandini began his career working for Nuccio Bertone at only age 27. (Among other well-respected designers, Nuccio Bertone has also earned a Lifetime Design Achievement Award from Eyes on Design, his in 2001.) Besides his work in entirety, many of Gandini's styling cues are timeless and have set the pace for exotic car design, one of the best examples being the scissor doors on the Countach.

This year, local Lamborghini owners came out and really made a great tribute to Gandini at Eyes on Design, bringing eight Lamborghinis to the show: an Espada, a Jarama, a Countach, and five Diablos. The total Lamborghini count was ten with the Gallardo Spyder and Murcielago LP640 that Lamborghini Troy brought to the show. Gandini would have definitely loved to see his design work as it was displayed at the show!

If the day could not be any more fun for the Lamborghini owners present, the event provided a special opportunity to meet car designer Bill Dayton. Bill, while working for Chrysler in the late 1980's, traveled to Italy under Lee lacocca's direction to modify and complete Gandini's design on the Diablo. For two years, Bill was submersed in the Italian culture and really had a chance to add his unique vision to the Diablo. A general conversation about car design with Bill quickly turned into a question-and-answer session on the design history of the Diablo. Bill provided some little-known facts about the Diablo (known as Project 132 in prototype stage): the spoiler is almost completely drag neutral and is 99% cosmetic styling, the center of drag is actually behind the vehicle, and the rear bumper adds important down force to the rear of the vehicle (the Countach was a little light in the rear at high speeds).

Then, in a rare occasion, Bill Dayton loaned his design scrapbook from his days in Italy working on the Diablo to the Midwest Region of Lamborghini Club America to review and copy – an in-depth newsletter feature on the Diablo will be coming soon! The scrapbook contains extremely rare photos and design notes on the Diablo – some of the images not being seen by anyone except those that were present while the photo was taken. One of those special photos is of Lamborghini legend, Valentino Balboni while he is on a test drive in a Diablo prototype! Other photos showed Diablo prototypes in different phases of the design process. Also included is a glimpse into the Italian - American controversy on what the car should look like, inside and out – stay tuned for more details!
